



The Facilities at The Station Master's House

The Station Master's House sleeps up to 4 guests, with a further 2 if required. It has two bedrooms, (one twin and one king size with a sofa bed in the sitting room), a bathroom, kitchen, dining room and sitting room. Outside there is a large secure yard area, (surrounded by garden), and laundry room.

There are views across the moors and towards Ribbleshead Viaduct, and of course, of all the trains that pass through the station.

Outside there is private parking for up to two cars.

You are welcome to arrive at any time after 3pm on the first day of your booking. You only need to put the kettle on and your holiday is underway!

A small complimentary supply of tea, coffee, sugar and milk will be provided, as well as all bed linen and towels.

On your final day you are requested to leave by 10am to allow us time to prepare the cottage for further guests.

Sitting Room:

TV with digital freeview access, DVD and DVDs (Rail and non-rail)

Dining Room:

Table and 6 chairs and a sideboard

Electric cooker, fridge, freezer, dishwasher, microwave, kettle & toaster
General cooking and dinnerware crockery, pans and utensils

Toilet, washbasin and mirror

External laundry room:

Washing machine & tumble dryer, iron and ironing board

Bedroom 1:

King size bed with duvet and bed linen, bedside tables with reading lamps
A wardrobe with hangers, chairs and set of drawers, hairdryer & mirror

Bedroom 2:

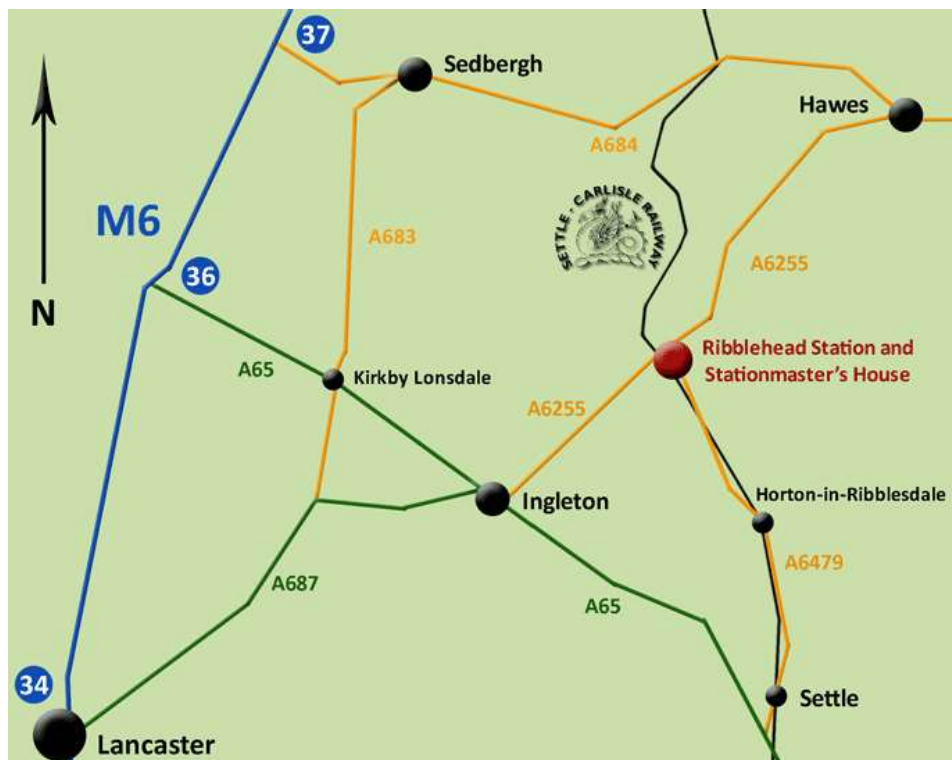
Two single beds with duvets and bed linen, bedside tables with reading lamps
